## **Vikings and the Sea**

Many of the sea routes that connect the world were discovered long before modern history begins. In Northern Europe during the Viking Age, unknown oceans were being transformed into familiar waters. Sailing ships travelled with ease between newly-established market towns and harbours, and made possible the discovery of new continents. This lecture will present some of the major archaeological finds of Viking ships and the impetus for the period's long-distance exploration that expanded all the way to the shores of today's Turkey.
