Historical Landscape of Seleukeia Sidera and Its Environment

This talk will focus on Seleukeia Sidera, which was founded as a colony during the period of the Seleukeians in the region of Pisidia. Nevertheless, investigations have revealed that settlement at Seleukeia Sidera substantially predates the Hellenistic period. As such, this talk will present the historical background of Seleukeia and its environs on the basis of the results from the surveys carried out in the region combined with the information gathered from the ongoing excavations as well as the knowledge collected from the continuing intangible cultural heritage project covering the wider region.
