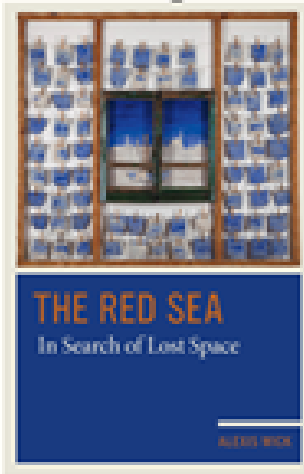

Please join us at 19:00 (Türkiye) for the next ARIT-INA-KUDAR online seminar with Dr. Alexis Wick from Koç University. Dr. Wick will discuss his recent book, *The Red Sea: In Search of Lost Space*.

The Red Sea: In Search of Lost Space argues that for millennia the Red Sea has been one of the world's most navigated spaces, yet this complex history is largely unexplored. Inspired by Braudel's studies of the Mediterranean, Wick's study of the Red Sea reveals the space's dynamism as well as its particularly unique features. By capturing this previously-unexplored space historically, however, the book also deconstructs conceptions and thinking about the space, leading to discussions of the hegemony of Eurocentric thinking and the sea's centrality to the philosophy of history. To conclude, Wick explores how the Red Sea may have been imagined and portrayed differently, prior to European hegemony, thus positing deeper arguments about the discipline of history and historian's practices.
